**MARRIAGES:** Specific time is set for the celebration of marriage on Saturdays. The common Policy for all the Dioceses of New Jersey requires a period of preparation for the sacrament of Marriage, which includes sessions with the parish priest and attendance at either the Pre-Cana conferences or the Engaged Encounter Weekend. Therefore, arrangements are to be made at least one year in advance and before any social plans are finalized.

**FIRST PENANCE, FIRST EUCHARIST, CONFIRMATION:** Though immediate preparation is given to children before receiving these sacraments, it is expected that children receive a Christian education within their family life, through formal religious education classes, and by attending Sunday worship services.

**PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:** Arrangements for Communion Calls to the sick at home may be made by calling the Parish Office.

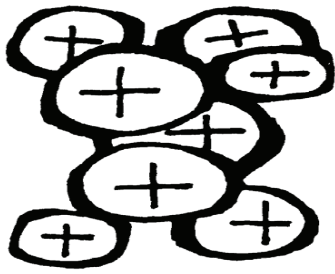

**ALL GOD'S CHILDREN**

Saint Paul in today's second reading talks about living as a Christian community. What he says sounds obvious: don't indulge in grudges, shouting, or name-calling. These are the things we teach our children from an early age, so they can develop as social persons who are able to live in harmony with others. However, what Paul is urging goes way beyond simple good manners. He is talking about an inner state of mind and heart that should mark all Christian behavior. Since we have been born into the spiritual family of God through baptism, courtesy and tolerance are evidence that our inner nature is forming itself in imitation of Christ. Our capacity for kindness and friendship shows our desire to build a community of love and mutual forgiveness. This can be hard enough in our own family, but can be even tougher in a parish. There is probably no other group that exhibits such a diversity of people as a parish. There are people from all walks of life and income levels. Some families were there when the parish was founded. Others arrived last week. For such a group to be drawn into a harmonious community is indeed divine work. It requires recognizing and honoring different gifts, and bearing differences with grace and acceptance. This unity in diversity of a people gathered around the one table of the one Lord proclaims the truth that in God there are no distinctions, only the family of God's children, beloved of the One who created all.
